2016 Bar Leaders Innovation Awards

The New York State Bar Association's Committee for Bar Leaders of New York State is pleased to open nominations for the 2016 Bar Leaders Innovation Awards for local, diverse, special purpose and specialty bar associations in New York State, as well as for the Women's Bar Association of the State of New York.

These awards recognize how bar associations adapt to the needs of their members and the community at large by introducing new programs, ideas and methodologies that benefit everyone involved. Every bar association is encouraged to participate. Every new idea put into effect, no matter how small it may seem, is welcome for consideration.

The awards program also provides information to bar leaders concerning new activities and projects that promote the public good, public understanding of the law or the professional responsibilities of attorneys.

The 2016 awards will be presented at the Annual Breakfast for Bar Leaders held at the New York Hilton Midtown on Friday, January 27, 2017 at 7:30 a.m.

Eligibility

Projects and programs designed and significantly implemented between **October 1, 2015 and September 30, 2016** are eligible for consideration.

Projects that were in place prior to October 1, 2015 are also welcome for consideration if innovations were made to the existing project that enhanced its scope and impact.

Nominated programs should:

- Involve or affect most of the members of the sponsoring association (or)
- Make a significant contribution to the bar and the public.

Examples

- Innovative Law Day Programs
- Pro Bono Projects
- Public Service Programs
- Youth and Adult Law-related Education Projects
- New Member Services
- Published reports and hosted programs supporting court reform and / or law reform

NEW Nomination Category

The Emerging Bar

This category recognizes the work of younger bar associations. These “emerging bars” often launch bold programs to establish a presence in the communities they serve.

Eligibility requirements are the same as detailed above, with submissions in this category accepted only from bar associations that officially formed within the past 10 years (i.e., since 2006).

Criteria for Evaluation

The criteria for evaluation of the nominations are:

- Effect of the project on the bar and/or the public
- Ingenuity and creativity in planning the project
- Overall quality of the project

Nomination Requirements

Complete nomination form

- Designate one appropriate category:
 - Smaller Bar associations – fewer than 500 members
 - Medium Bar associations – 500 – 1,999 members
 - Larger Bar associations – 2,000 members or more
 - Emerging Bar – Incorporated less than 10 years (since 2006)
- Attach any additional supporting materials and submit online as directed
- Only one entry per association
