Malinowski obtained the Advanced Public Information Officers certification through FEMA and has also attended several national training seminars that bring Public Information Officers from around the country to debrief national incidents and develop best practices.

Prior to his current assignment, Sgt. Malinowski served five years in the Patrol Division as a Patrol Officer. In 2017, he was promoted to Sergeant and supervised Patrol Officers on the midnight shift.
